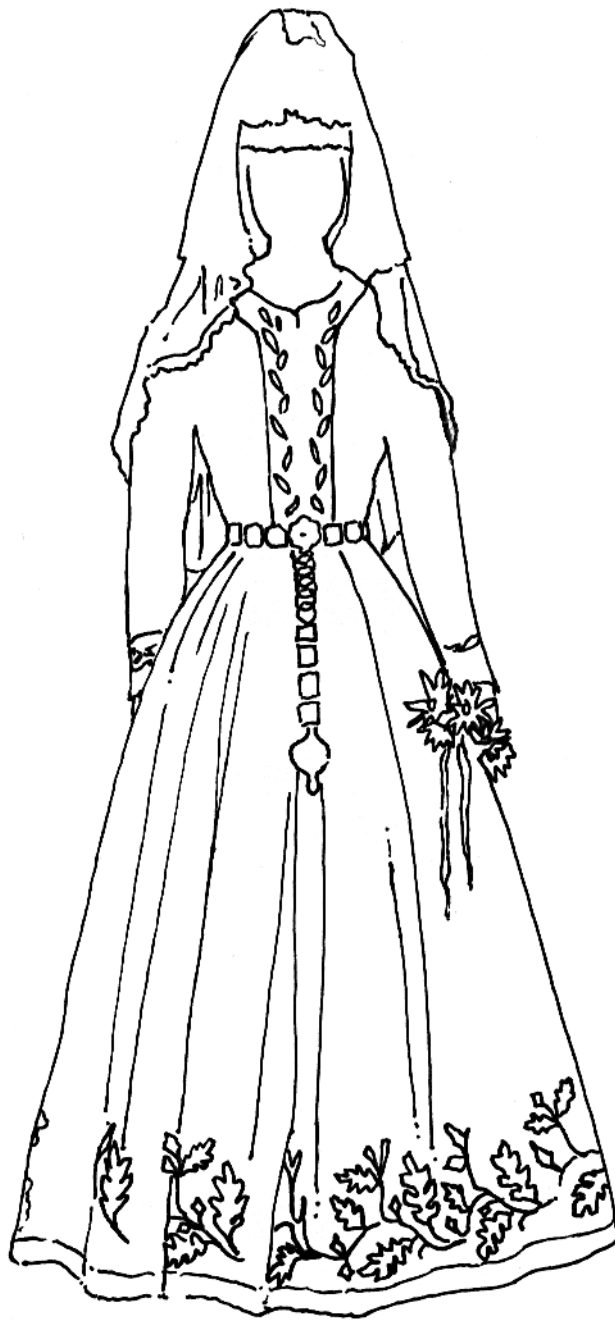


A WORLD OF COLOUR
