

## **Tying Naval Knots**

To be a sailor in Canada's navy and to work with flags and sails, it was essential to be able to tie a variety of knots. Try your hand at tying these common naval knots.

A BOWLINE makes a non-slip loop in the end of a line.



A REEF KNOT is used to tie two ropes of equal thickness together. When this knot is improperly tied it's called a GRANNY KNOT (not a very secure knot)!


